

**COASTLINE COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
SCHOLARSHIP GUIDE  
2008-2009**

Scholarships are made available through the generous donations of Coastline Community College's Foundation, Student Advisory Council (SAC), faculty, staff, businesses, community organizations, and individuals. Scholarship awards vary in amount, ranging from \$150 and up. A student may also be eligible for more than one scholarship. Scholarship Awards Committee members include administrators, classified staff, faculty, students, and a college foundation board member. Factors for selection can include academic achievement, service, leadership, college and community involvement, and/or financial need.

- All applicants are required to submit a **2008-2009** Coastline Scholarship Application by Monday, March 9, 2009. Incomplete applications will be invalid.
- Scholarship awards shall be presented to recipients at the Scholarship Awards Reception on **Thursday, April 23, 2009.** **Attendance is mandatory.**
- All recipients are required to send a thank you card to their scholarship donor prior to receiving their award. Directions and information shall be provided to recipients at the time of notification.

**ALL APPLICANTS WILL BE NOTIFIED OF THE COMMITTEE'S DECISION DURING THE MONTH OF APRIL 2009.**

**GENERAL CRITERIA**

- Enrollment in at least five (5) units at Coastline Community College during the **Fall 2008 OR Spring 2009 - unless stipulated otherwise.**
- Completion of at least five (5) units with a letter grade at Coastline Community College by the end of the **Fall 2008** semester.
- SAC Merit Scholarship recipients must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average (GPA) from Coastline Community College and must have paid the College Services Charge to qualify for a SAC Merit Scholarship.
- A minimum cumulative 2.5 grade point average (GPA) from Coastline Community College for any other scholarship - **unless stipulated otherwise.**
- The majority of scholarships awarded are NOT based on financial need.
- Acceptable academic progress at Coastline College (students on probation or suspension are not eligible).
- Only Coastline Community College transcripts will be considered for academic requirements.
- Any student on disciplinary probation will be ineligible for a scholarship.
