George James, A.W.S. – D.F., N.W.S., is a professor emeritus of art at California State University Fullerton. By abandoning traditional methods of painting, he has discovered a new, creative watercolor process. As a result of this new and unique approach to watercolor painting, his most recent work has been recognized in major exhibitions and periodicals. His awards have included the AWS High Winds Award (2007, 2003), NWS Silver Star Medal, AWS Bronze Medal (2001, 1998) and the 1999 AWS Gold Medal.
