DROP DATES

First 8-week courses (January 31 - March 29)

10% of the course	Deadline to receive a refund
First 30% of the course	Deadline to avoid transcript entry "W"
First 75% of the course	Deadline to receive "W" grade

Mid 8-week Courses (March 2 - May 3)

10% of the course	Deadline to receive a refund
First 30% of the course	Deadline to avoid transcript entry "W"
First 75% of the course	Deadline to receive "W" grade

Second 8-Week Courses (April 6 - May 31)

10% of the course	Deadline to receive a refund
First 30% of the course	Deadline to avoid transcript entry "W"

DEADLINE TO SELECT PASS/NO PASS GRADING OPTION

Students wishing to select the Pass/No Pass grading method in grade option courses must file the request in the Admissions and Records office within the first 30% of the length of the course. The P/NP deadline date is the same as the last day to drop without a "W". Refund policy for enrollment, health, material, nonresident tuition and parking fees for short-term classes is the refund cutoff date on which 10 percent of the class meetings have occurred. Refer to your Student Schedule/Bill at MyCCC for exact refund dates.
